about the current affair in Iran.

Protesting the fallout of the election in Iran has resulted in wide spread demonstrations against the government of Iran. Finally after 30 years of autocracy and barbaric repression, people in Iran presented in the alleys and streets of Iran to shake the pillar of the Republic Islamic of Iran. The Iranian regime has not been successful in changing the Iranian people's struggle. In fact the waves of anger have changed to a serious desire for change. The people's protest and anger is against Iranian government as a whole. This has been highlighted in the world media and made the world and its politician to look and worry about Iran.

By the slogans like "long live freedom", "death to dictator"" and "death to Khamenei" have echoed across the country and demagogy of 30 years autocracy and dictatorial government is fallen off.

More than 10 dead, hundreds arrested and thousands wounded are the price that Iranian people are paying to achieve freedom.
